## Clarification of Provisions Regarding Utilisation of the System Without Holding System Capacity



Proposer: National Gas Transmission

# Why change?



- TPD Sections
  - I and J include provisions which set out that Transporters obligations to accept deliveries of gas and make gas available for offtake (respectively) are limited to the relevant capacity held by Users; and
  - B sets out the consequences for Users of flowing in excess of capacity (Overruns, Supply Point Ratchets etc.)
- Transmission Workgroup debate on interaction between these two aspects i.e. do the Section B provisions need to acknowledge the extent of Transporters obligations in respect of gas flows in TPD Section I and J?

# Options



- Do nothing – commercial arrangements still ‘work’ however lack of clarity regarding interaction between TPD Sections I/J and B maintained
- Include a cross reference in TPD Section B to TPD Sections I/J to enhance clarity in UNC

# Solution

  - ‘in spite of the limitations regarding Transporters obligations to accept deliveries of gas and make gas available for offtake in excess of Capacity, where for any reason a User does flow in excess of these Capacity holdings, the relevant additional Charges will be payable.’

- Workgroup assessment to develop the modification for 3 months
