

APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO MODIFY THE NETWORK CODE

1. Transco Proposal

The Network Code currently restricts the booking of all Storage Capacity after 30th November.

At the Modification Panel meeting held on the 18th December 1997 a discussion was held to increase firm deliverability from Storage at times of peak demand. It was decided that it would be advantageous if firm Storage Capacity booking could be available all year, and Transco agreed to apply to Ofgas for consent to modify the Network Code to allow this.

2. Nature of the Modification

Section R, Paragraph 3.8.2

Insert the word "Interruptible" such that the whole paragraph reads:-

"3.8.2 No application for Interruptible Storage Capacity may be made after 30th November in the Storage Year."

3. Transco Application

Transco now seeks the consent of the Director General to modify the Network Code in accordance with the above proposal. Once received Transco will circulate a Notice of Implementation stating the effective date.
