This scenario should be covered under the ERR/FRJ rejections? If this rejection code is intended for a different reason, please amend the description so that it is meaningful. <i>“Removal of rejection code AQI00022. Rejection code MRE00419 will apply in this scenario”</i> – British Gas accepts this. Please include AQR file against MRE00419 rejection code. <i>“Removal of rejection code MRE00414 due to existing rejection code CNF00011 having a higher validation level which will mean that MRE00414 will never be triggered and therefore redundant”</i> UDR,UMR,UBR,SFN,URS & SFR files are mapped against CNF00011 and MPR00011 rejection codes. We have re-used an existing code so that we didn't create a new rejection code. The rejection code proposed is intended to indicate that in circumstances a field must be populated. Creating a new rejection code was not considered a 'must have change'. Agreed – the AQR file will be included against MRE00419. Please see a revised version of the rejection codes attached. MPR00011 is used for SFN/MAM files. All other files will generate the CNF00011 file. Please see a revised version of the rejection codes attached.

The change pack only seems to mention the “found” UPD exchange. 	<p>Thank you for your comment.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) New rejection codes have been added to the Shipper Rejection code list, which have previously been approved at UKLC. This change summary is to inform Users following the revision of the Treatment in Reading process that it would be likely that Users would experience an increase of rejections for such transactions. 2) Yes, it is expected that the UPDTE code can be provided on UPD flows following Nexus Implementation. FOUND / REMVD was referenced as the DUC Code (A0178) gives the context of the asset in the UPD – i.e. the asset being removed or installed.
