Dear colleague,

An extraordinary UKLC was convened on 20th May to discuss the change that was proposed to the K88 and K89 records within the .ASP file format (issued within communication **1575.1 – LH – DA - Clarification on the treatment of RECONCILIATION INVOICE CHARGE within the ASP File Format**).

Following close out of the representation period five responses were received. 4 responses indicated rejection of the change, while one had supported it. At the above meeting, Xoserve indicated that they wished to have the opportunity to consider representations, and where necessary issue an amended Change Summary.

Please see attached a presentation that clarifies the way that Users would expect to receive Reconciliation Invoice Charge Information as set out in the above Change Summary (Option 1) contrasted against how we understand Users have indicated that they might expect to receive these (Option 2).

Please see attached the representation comments for this change.

It was agreed that the UK Link Committee would vote on the above. In doing so, Users are asked to note that the way that Option 2 has been interpreted was not as anticipated, therefore a clarification would be proposed to the formats by the following changes:

- The K88 and K89 records will have a sentence to the effect of *“Solely LSP variances are included within these records, please refer to the .AML for the SSP variances applicable within this reconciliation period”*

This will be a description change and will be issued subsequently if required.

If this option is selected this represents a functional change and the change will not be released prior to the next reconciliation invoice within Market Trials on 26th May; this will still reflect the SSP variances (if any rec period for a threshold crosser spans the 1st February, dummy ‘Go live’ date there will be values for the SSP variances. Periods prior to this will show zero values as rec will be processed under RbD methodology).

The original Change Summary is attached for information. This remains the preferred approach for Xoserve.

Dear colleague,

During UK Link Committee (UKLC) on 12th May the treatment of the RECONCILIATION_INVOICE_CHARGE records in the .ASP File Format was discussed. The K88 is used to show the reconciliation charges for Class 4 LSP sites and the K89 for Class 3.

Following Project Nexus Implementation Date, Small Supply Point (SSP) sites are subject to individual meter point reconciliation. Details of such reconciliation are included within the .ASP File Format in the K90 Record (RECONCILIATION_INV_AGGREGATE_DETAIL_CLASS_3_4_SSP) which provides this information at an aggregate level.

In the circumstances where a Supply Meter Point AQ has changed between the start and end of a reconciliation period (i.e. threshold crossers) this will result in both SSP and Large Supply Point (LSP) variances being generated within this reconciliation period.

We are proposing that where charges for a reconciliation period are displayed within the .ASP File Format for Class 3 and Class 4 sites where one or more variances relate to a period when the Supply Meter Point was SSP, the entire reconciliation period will be shown in the detailed record of K88 and K89 respectively i.e. the K88 and K89 will also include SSP variance periods in such circumstances.

The SSP values for these reconciliations will not be included within the Aggregate Record K90.

Within Market Trials a defect was raised as a User identified that variances relating to SSP sites were included within the K88 record.

For supporting information currently issued in Market Trials, these reconciliation periods show zero values for the SSP variances with no charges as they are reconciled under RbD (Reconciliation by Difference) rules. From the 'Go Live' date in testing and in production SSP variances will be populated with financial values for the variances post 'Go Live'.

In these circumstances Users will have clear visibility of the energy and charges for these sites for the reconciliation period. Failure to show the SSP variants will split reconciliation periods between files and impact the Users ability to validate invoices.

Whilst explicitly this will not affect the UK Link File Formats the record names currently used are *RT_K88_RECONCILIATION_INVOICE_CHARGE_CLASS_4_LSP* and *RT_K89_RECONCILIATION_INVOICE_CHARGE_CLASS_1_2_AND_CLASS_3_LSP*. Users should note that variances will include SSP if applicable.

It is proposed at a later date to change the title of the K90 record from *RT_K90_RECONCILIATION_INV_AGGREGATE_DETAIL_CLASS_3_4_SSP* to *RT_K90_RECONCILIATION_INV_AGGREGATE_DETAIL_CLASS_3_4_EXCLUSIVELY_SSP* to distinguish these records and also remove references to LSP in the K88 and K89 records.

As the next amendment invoice will be issued within Market Trials on 26th May Users expressed a desire to have this proposal agreed before this date. During UKLC the committee agreed for a reduced representation period. Please submit comments to uklink@xoserve.com by 5:00pm on 19th May 2016. We will be seeking approval at UKLC on 20th May at 9:30am hosted by Joint Office.

British Gas	Oorlagh Chapman	18/05/2016	Support	Y	<p>Please may we clarify, is it certain that a Supplier receives k88 or k89 for meter point level detail even if the site was never an LSP and always an SSP?</p> <p>In the attached word document it states: 'Whilst explicitly this will not affect the UK Link File Formats the record names currently used are <i>RT_K88_RECONCILIATION_INVOIC E_CHARGE_CLASS_4_LSP</i> and <i>RT_K89_RECONCILIATION_INVOIC E_CHARGE_CLASS_1_2_ AND_CLASS_3_LSP</i>. Users should note that variances will include SSP if applicable.'</p> <p>Please clarify why it says if applicable – Would it not always be applicable for the variance to be included?</p> <p>British Gas concluded that they accept this change</p>	<p>If the site was solely SSP for the whole reconciliation period the values will be added into the aggregated values (under K90) and would be viewed via the second level supporting information at individual MPRN level and no information would be presented within the K88 or K89 record.</p> <p>This communication is referring to process required to accommodate threshold crossers within a reconciliation period.</p> <p>Between two reads if there are one or more variances where the site AQ puts it in to the SSP market the reconciliation period and all associated variances will be provided in the individual reconciliation records under K88 or K89, along with the LSP variances covering the whole reconciliation period.</p> <p>This SSP element would not be added into the aggregated values under K90 if presented as part of a threshold crosser reconciliation period</p>

We have built our systems to validate and reconcile our invoices for SSP and LSP reconciliations for all supply points when they are in the relevant category, and we would expect all records within the .ASP file formats to be correct for SSPs and LSPs at all times, including where there has been a change from one category to another during a reconciliation period.</p> <p>We see this change as a defect which has been identified in market trials and one which Xoserve should correct in order to ensure that shippers get the correct reconciliation invoice information at all times based on the correct categorisation of SSPs and LSPs. The ASP would have the LSP elements in the K88/K89 and the SSP elements aggregated in the K90 in line with the current file format. Bobbie Gallagher	Scottish Power	19/05/2019	Not in Support	Y	<p>The proposal seems to suggest that where a Class 4 MPRN changes from SSP to LSP (or vice versa), then the entire reconciliation period will be reported on the ASP file and that the SSP portion will be excluded from the Class 3 & 4 SSP aggregation record.</p> <p>Currently we believe (and through the development of GINA) that charges should be generated as SSP up to the point where the Market Category changes to LSP, therefore the SSP period will be on the AML file and the subsequent LSP charges on the ASP file.
