2. Invoicing Principles Workgroup

2.1 Terms of Reference Development

xoserve (FC) provided a brief overview of the 'Invoicing Mechanism Principle Topic Workgroup Terms of Reference' document (v0.1 dated 07/10/2010), highlighting that most of the IRR comments that would be in scope are primarily high-level, aspirational (best practices) requirements, which possibly questions the benefit of conducting specific individual invoicing meetings at this stage and until further market information becomes available.

Moving through the document, FC pointed out that currently credit information is held within the respective Transporter's individual credit systems. National Grid NTS (SMc) suggested that consideration of, and development of, aspects of the future credit requirements maybe better served by raising a UNC modification in due course. Gazprom (SM) also suggested that he believes that as discussions in the various topic workgroups continue and develop, the subject of invoicing requirements will need to be revisited whilst also being mindful of any emerging (new) modifications.

FC informed those present that she believes that clarity from the Authority over what Smart Metering solution options are preferred, should surface in early 2011 (possible January).

Whilst parties readily acknowledged that the Project Nexus work undertaken to date has been useful, one member indicated his frustration at what he sees as a lack of (Nexus) progress and anticipates raising a new UNC modification in due course, to address his (and his company's) more immediate business issues and requirements.

In closing, Chair (BF) asked, and parties agreed to put the matter of the Invoicing Terms of Reference 'on hold' until such a time as the Authority's Smart Metering information is made available in early 2011.

FC apologised for the late provision of the plan before providing a brief verbal update. She went on to highlight that the next AMR Detailed Workgroup meeting is scheduled for 16/11/10 and the work area is currently marked as amber to reflect a slight slippage.
