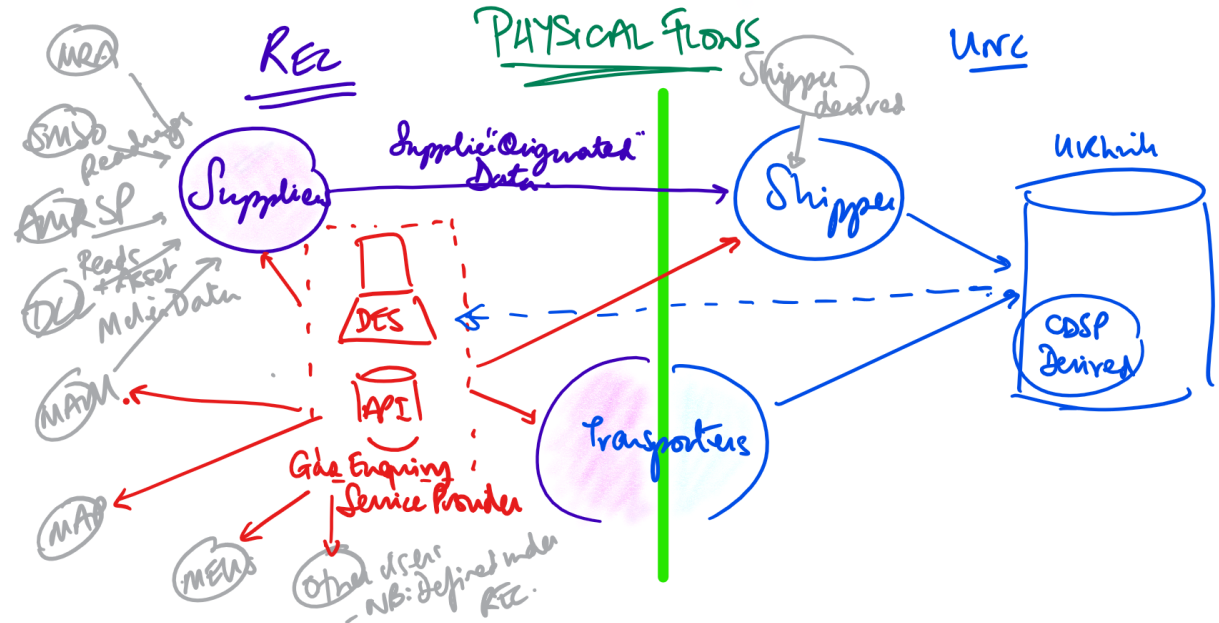

Background

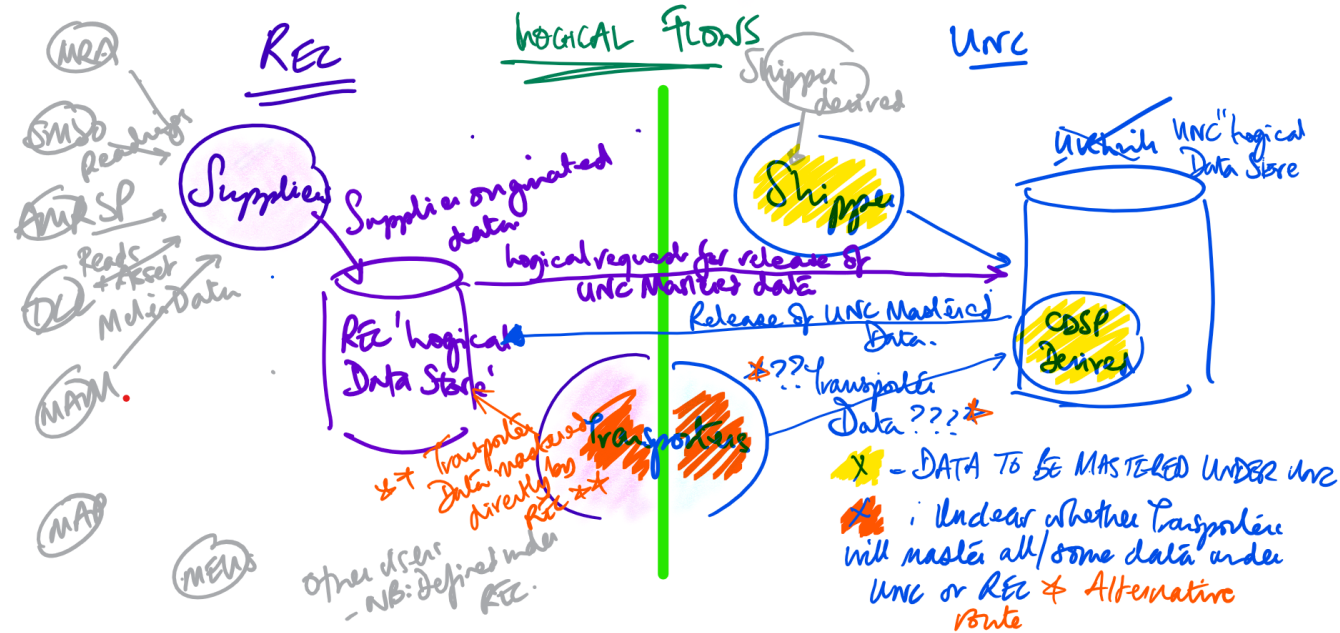
- Under UNC, [some] Protected Information is controlled by the Data Permission Matrix released to parties defined in Section V5 of the UNC
- Following REC v2/v3 implementation then permission to release data will also be defined under the REC
- We need to determine the treatment of the data items – which are controlled solely by the REC, and which are controlled under the UNC

Physical Data Flows between REC / UNC



NB: CDSP = Xoserve (for now) under contract to REC Co.

Logical Data Flows between REC / UNC



Questions

- Are the data sources correct / exhaustive?
 - Noting that post CSS a source of Registration data will be CSS
- Is the Logical treatment correct?
 - Suppliers will logically provide direct to the REC (regardless of the physical route)
 - Do Shippers expect to apply confidentiality based on physical or logical flows of data?
 - Shipper derived data will be mastered under UNC
 - Assumed as Shippers will not want data to be released without their ability to influence this
 - CDSP derived data is mastered under UNC
 - Assumed as this is derived under UNC, it should be controlled by the UNC
 - Transporters as party to both can decide WHICH code to master under
