### UNC 0747:

Amendment of reference from AIGT to INA within the UNC

# Why change?

- The Independent Networks Association (INA) was introduced in 2020 and merged the existing independent associations of the AIGT and the equivalent electricity Competitive Networks Association (CNA) into one body, the INA.
- The trade association represents the interests of IGTs and all independent licenced companies are eligible to become members.
- The text within the UNC needs amending to reflect this merger as is currently incorrect.
- The AIGT is referenced on four occasions within the UNC Modification Rules and four occasions in the General Terms Section – CDSP and UK Link, the text needs replacing from AIGT to INA.

## **Options**

- •This Modification is a housekeeping change to amend the reference from AIGT to INA. The only option required is to amend the references from AIGT to INA.
- AIGT is referenced on four occasions within the UNC Modification Rules and four occasions in the General Terms Section – CDSP and UK Link.
- •The company number for the INA has also been amended to reflect the change. The previous AIGT company number has ceased, the new company number is the previous number for the equivalent electricity company number, the CNA.

### Solution

- •Amending the legal text within the UNC Modification Rules to replace the four references of AIGT to INA and to update the company registration number to reflect the change of company number.
- •Amending the legal text from UNC General Terms, Section D- CDSP and UK Link Annex 2 Committee Representatives to replace the reference from AIGT to INA.

### Recommended Steps

#### The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:

- Subject to Fast Track self-governance because the proposed amendments to the UNC Modification Rules and General Terms are simply correcting references and are immaterial in their impacts.
- This Modification is purely administrative and has no impact to any party.
- The legal text is currently inaccurate so the sooner the changes can be implemented the better, to ensure accurate administration of the code.
- Presented to Panel on 17<sup>th</sup> December who will determine the appropriate route.
