

## GCD13 update:

August.2023



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- Seventeen responses received. Documentation available here:

- Some of the themes (summarised) raised in the responses (not exhaustive)
  - Need for compliance with EU Codes (i.e. how TAR NC is incorporated into UK Law)
  - Many acknowledge the issue/influence from Existing Contracts in the charging methodology and its impact to prices but challenging to see precisely what is the best way to address
  - Timing and how long it may take to address noting that the impact will eventually reduce over time
  - Reviewing or discussing potential change to the 50/50 split mostly supported but a number of concerns / points have been noted as impacts if this were changed
    - Some noting if there are bigger changes, these should be done in parallel
- Dominating the responses was the need to consider compliance
  - Noting previous determinations on charging related proposals and the criticality of EU compliance in development and ultimately decisions made by Ofgem.
  - Some options considered might be compliant could however be challenges of putting it in practise to retain that compliance

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
