### Scope

All the requirements detailed under Article 26 of TAR NC will be included in the consultation document or in data tables that will be published alongside the consultation document.

Unlike in 2019, there are no developed alternative proposals to the current charging methodology.

The consultation will lay out charging methodology at the time of publication.

This consultation will not replace the established UNC change process as the primary vehicle for progressing industry change to charging methodologies.

Stakeholders will be provided the opportunity to comment on different aspects of the reference price methodology currently in place through the consultation questions.

Views could be used to inform future discussions and development of the Transmission and Non-Transmission regimes.

# How the respond

- The consultation is expected to be published on 16 February 2024 and will be open for a period of 2 months. It is open to any parties interested in gas transmission charging.
- When live, the consultation document will be published on <u>Gas Charging Discussion (GCD) Papers</u> page of the National Gas Transmission website and a link will be sent out via the Joint Office.
