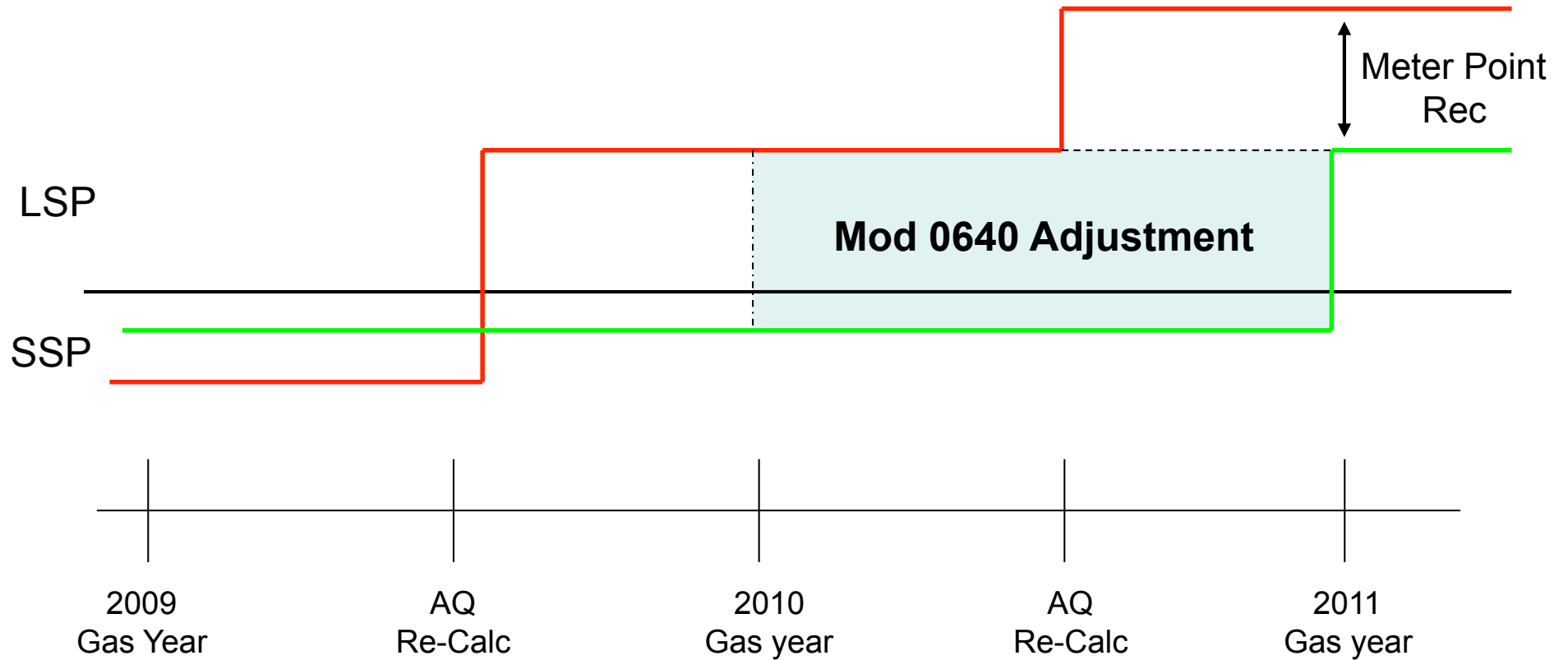
- Action from 18th July meeting (NEX07/16)
 - To consider potential Mod 640 impacts on the AQ calculation threshold crossers
- Current Arrangements for Mod 0640 'End of Year Reconciliation of Specific Categories of Smaller Supply Points'
 - Where a SSP becomes a LSP as a result of the AQ Review in Year 2, the Year 2 AQ would be used to reconcile the Supply Point for Year 1

Interaction with Meter Point Rec

- The end of year 'Threshold Crosser' adjustments are required to ensure transportation & energy charges are appropriately borne by the relevant User of the Supply Point.
- Sites can remain in SSP sector for upto 18 months after an increase in consumption
- Conclusion.....???
 - Meter Point Rec for all sites would account for the increase in meter consumption
 - With or without a Rolling AQ
 - AQ would be corrected at the next review

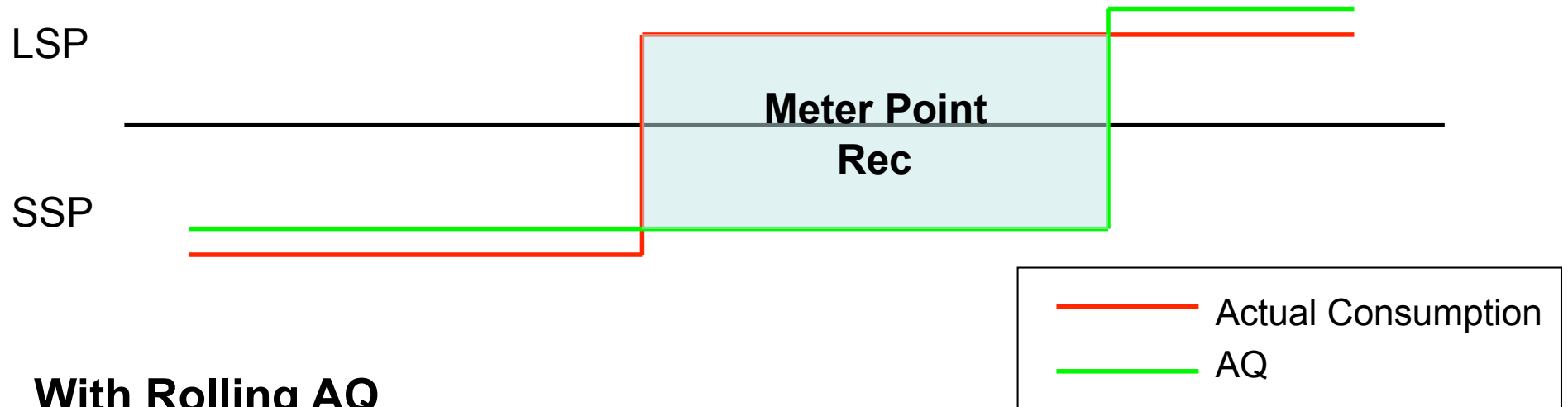

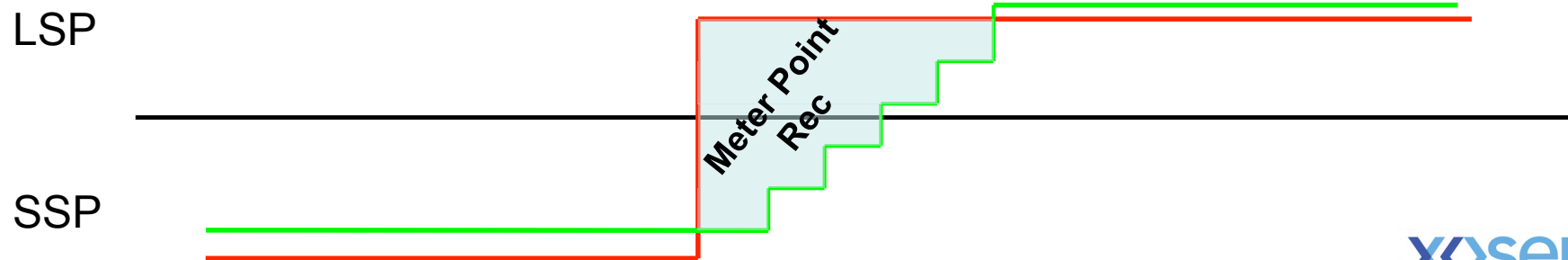
