
# PAC501 Action High Level Shipper Process for Correction Factor Updates





## **Changes following Rolling AQ Update**

### **XOServe Notifications**

- DMM after 3 times in the preceding 18 months not in Product 1
- DMM and in Product 1
- Below DMM Threshold and in Product 1
- Site Specific Correction Factor
- Meter Read Frequency
- Emergency Contact Details
- Priority Consumer Threshold
- DNI eligibility threshold

#### **Extract from Annual Quantity BRD**

#### 8.7 Threshold Crossers

- 8.7.1 As part of the AQ process, where an AQ crosses an AQ threshold, either above or below, that requires the Shipper to take action, a notification will be issued to the Shipper. The criteria where a notification will be issued are;
- 8.7.1.1 Where the Revised AQ of a Meter Point is greater than 58,600,000 kWh for 3 consecutive calculations of the AQ or for 3 calculations in the preceding 18 month period, but is not already classified as a DM Mandatory site and within Product 1, the Daily Read Requirement will apply. Where an AQ has reached the DM Mandatory threshold, or where currently in Product 1 where the AQ is below the DM Mandatory threshold, a notification will be issued to the Shipper and the relevant GT notifying of the Revised AQ.

Note: The responsibility remains with the Shipper to liaise with the relevant Network for Daily Read Equipment to be installed and transfer the Supply Meter Point into Class 1.

- 8.7.1.2 Where a Supply Meter Point in Product 4 is not recorded as a Monthly Meter Read Frequency but exceeds 293,000 kWh a notification will be sent to the Shipper
- 8.7.1.3 Where Emergency Contact Details are required due to the AQ of the Supply meter Point, a notification will be sent to the Shipper
- 8.7.1.4 Where a Supply Meter Point is classified as a Priority Consumer but the AQ has fallen below the AQ threshold a notification will be issued to the Shipper
- 8.7.1.5 Where a Supply Meter Point requires a site specific Correction factor
- 8.7.1.6 Where the Supply Meter Point has a Distribution Network Interruption (DNI) contract but the AQ has fallen below the eligibility threshold for DNI.
