DME Notification

In relation to the CB938LP Representation Matrix Response issued, xoserve proposed that in addition to the use of the Enquiry file the TRF option 5 would be developed. Following discussions at Februarys UK Link Committee meeting the shippers have requested that xoserve complete a further review cycle to understand if for the TRF option

1. Would you as a shipper use the TRF file to determine a sites previous GNT code.
2. Would any system changes be required to receive the data populated in the DATALOGGER\_SERIAL\_NUMBER field.

If the feedback received indicates that the TRF file will not be used or will require system changes to receive then xoserve will de-scope this option. Pre-notification of a sites current GNT code will be obtained by submission of an Enquiry (via NOM file) and the responding NMR file. Could you please provide any responses to the above by the close of play on 26th February 2010.
