COR1000.9 IX Upgrade

Current position

- The rollout of new server hardware is progressing with 8 sites outstanding. Weekly conference calls are being maintained with these sites to confirm site access requirements and agree appointment dates for either a migration or refresh.
- Arranging circuit appointments for some sites still remain a challenge due to site access requirements for out of hours or weekend appointments.
- Xoserve and 3rd party provider are exploring alternative circuit solutions for sites where access is not achievable for proposed circuit solution due to site access constraints.

Future Steps

- Conclude server migration / refresh appointments for 8 remaining sites.
 to support Gemini Re-Platforming Readiness Testing to commence.
- Booking server migration appointments to refreshed sites where circuit installations have now been completed.
- Identify alternative circuit solutions (if required) and continue to deliver new circuit capability into outstanding sites.



COR1000.1 – EFT Globalscape XFTM Co-Existence

- Phase 1 Inter Data Centre File Transfers
 - -4/3 20/3
 - Internal customers only
- Phase 2a Outbound IX File Transfers
 - **21/3 27/3**
 - File type by file type roll out
 - Communication provided the week before to confirm position
 - Dual log files in operation
- Phase 2b Inbound IX File Transfers
 - **28/3 30/4**
 - Phased roll out over period
 - Shipper by shipper roll out Pilot and Trial Sites prior to initiation of Roll Out
 - Generic notification to Users once roll out concluded

Current Position

- Migration of Phase 1 Inter Data Centre File transfers has commenced and is progressing well
 - On schedule to complete 20/3
- Phase 2a migration is on track to start on 21/3
 - Test (TN) file will be issued to all Shippers for .ERR file type on Day 1
 - TN files will be issued to volunteer Shippers for all other file types as they are migrated
 - No action is required, TN file (s) can be ignored
