Dear Colleague,

Further to the discussions at the February UK Link Committee regarding the potential amendment to the solution for implementation of UNC Modification 403. This amended approach has been withdrawn by the potential Modification proposer.

As proposed, this change was taken to the Distribution Workgroup to obtain a view regarding the need for this amended business rule, and therefore the requirement for a Modification. This meeting understood the requirement for Xoserve to get a consensus view at this time whether this change should be pursued in order to maintain the stated delivery timescales and implementation costs. The Workgroup concluded that the change was not required and therefore did not necessarily support the Modification proposal.

In view of this response, there is no requirement to hold the Extraordinary UK Link Committee scheduled for 10am (Friday 1st March) for the Committee, planned to ratify the revised implementation plan.
