## **Contact Type**

Contact Type is the type of association being maintained such as Emergency Contact, Isolation Contact.

Currently there are ten Contact Types, a number of these are historic.

Sites over 732,000 kWh require an Emergency Contact, part of the requested Information includes Contact Type.

	There are 10 different types of contact types currently held on UK Link
	4 of the types are valid and being migrated:- EMR, CON, ISC, ISO
Summary	The remaining 6 are legacy and require cleansing:-
	INC,INO,TEL,INT,OTH & EME (17,648 affected records)
	INC & INO were used for the Interruption process which no longer exists.
	TEL, INT & EME are historic codes OTH was used only once in 1998
	OTTI was used only once in 1990
Migration Impact	SAP will allow only EMR, CON, ISO and ISC contact type, the remaining contact types will not get migrated.

Recommended Options	Cleansing of the non allowable values     Transform during migration to a default value e.g. EMR or CON
FMR – Emergency	INIO Latermentian (name) INIO Latermentian Organization

EMR – Emergency
CON – Consumer
ISC – Isolation (person)
ISO – Isolation Organisation

INC – Interruption (person)
TEL – Telephone
EME – Emergency

INO – Interruption Organisation INT - Invalid OTH - Other

### **Electronic Address**

ELA Type is the Electronic Address Type for contact information.

This method includes Fax, Pager & Telephone

There are currently 7 ELA types held in UK Link.

Four ELA types will be migrated to SAP



### **Electronic Address Type**

#### **Summary**

- There are 7 different Electronic Address types currently held on UK Link
- 4 of the types are valid and being migrated:
- TEL, FAX, PAG or blank
- The remaining 3 are legacy and require cleansing:
- TEX, BTG & EMR (23 sites)

#### Migration Impact

SAP will allow only TEL, FAX, PAG or blank as ELA\_TYPEs, the remaining will not get migrated.

#### Design Impact

N/A

### Recommended Options

- 1. Cleansing of the non allowable values
- 2. Transformation to blank at migration but this is not the recommended option

TEL – Telephone FAX – Facsimile PAG – Pager Blank – Blank

TEX – Telex EMR – Emergency
