3. Review of Work Plan

3.1. Suggested Workplan

MP explained that no suggested work plan ideas had been received from DESC for this year. Therefore proposals for adhoc analysis in Autumn / Winter 2011 were based around comments made at the February DESC meeting. Firstly, MP described proposals for Band 1 analysis. MJ asked about splitting EUC Band 1 into an extra sub category, rather than only at 10MWh pa and 20 MWh pa. There was consensus in favour of considering this, which MP agreed to consider.

Post Meeting Note:

To clarify sub band analysis will look at splitting the current Band 1 of 0-73.2 MWh pa into three sub bands, namely 0-10, 10-20 and 20-73.2 MWh pa

Secondly, MP proposed looking at the cold weather period between late November and late January in more detail when looking at the annual NDM sample analysis results presented each February. PA suggested extending this to shoulder months where models did not behave well. MP agreed to extend the analysis to include some hot days in order to show the extremes.

It was agreed that these extra analyses would be completed in addition to the standard annual programme.

3.2. NDM Sample update

LW summarised the changes in sample numbers across a range of sub categories, and the efforts made to ensure robust sample numbers are maintained.

MJ asked whether the need to get customer permission biased the sample towards a particular class of household. LW acknowledged that this is possible, although efforts are made to encourage take-up with, for example, incentives being offered.

4. Any Other Business

4.1. Modification 0330 Legal text

ST reported that legal text will be submitted today and will be issued with the Draft Modification Report. If all could review the text and ensure it delivers the intent of the modification, that would be appreciated. Modification 0331 is expected to be in the same position.
