Data Cleansing – Correction Factor

- Topic - Correction Factor (also known as Meter Correction factor)
- Definition - a factor applied to the consumption to correct for physical factors associated with gas passing through the meter e.g. height above sea level
- For SSP a standard correction factor is applied at M Number creation
- For LSP, the Shipper is responsible for providing
- The Shipper is responsible for maintaining the Correction Factor
- Analysis has identified 6000 meters with inconsistent Correction Factors

Data Cleansing – Correction Factor

- For LSP meters the impact is on reconciliation
- For all meters the impact is on AQ calculation
- The Correction Factor is provided with the asset installation data
- Shippers can update the Correction Factor using RGMA update flows

Data Cleansing Correction Factor

- The Correction Factor is available to Shippers in:
 - User Pays email reporting service – report 6
 - User Pays portfolio report – Registered User Portfolio Report
 - User Pays portfolio report – Annual Asset Portfolio
 - User Pays portfolio report – Historic Asset and Read Portfolio
 - User Pays – Data Enquiry Service
- To assist all Shippers, a specific one-off portfolio will be provided detailing those meters identified with an inconsistent factor
- Xoserve shall monitor the population for progress of resolution
