<u>Subject: AQ Process 2007 - Thursday 20th September to Monday 8th October</u>

The AQ Process is an annual series of events which culminates in the recalculation of the annual quantity for all NDM meter points. You will be aware from previous years that this is a major transactional event which requires processing an extraordinary volume of data. It will impact on the way we process SPA files and data availability on IAD over the next couple of weeks.

We are now entering the busiest time for this year's AQ process. Between Thursday 20th and Monday 24th September all SPA files will be put on hold to allow for the preparation for uploading data onto the UK Link system. The SPA file processing is planned to start again from Monday 24th with all file processing being up-to-date by Saturday 29th September.

From Monday 1st October the new gas year data is loaded onto the system. Again all SPA file processing will be put on hold until Thursday 4th October. SPA file processing will start again with all file processing being up-to-date by Monday 8th October.

During this period both IAD and any time-tabled reports will not be carrying the latest information because of the hold on processing SPA files. In addition, we expect IAD to run slowly between Monday $1^{\rm St}$ and Thursday $4^{\rm th}$ October as we update the data tables that support this system.
