EH/772/AE - UKL1094 - Redesignation of Supply Point Capacity as Firm

A Shipper/Supplier of an Interruptible Supply Point may, subject to certain restrictions, apply to the DN Operator to redesignate some or all of the Supply Point Capacity as Firm. This may arise, for example, from a change of consumer at the Supply Point. Such a change in designation would result in a variation in the Interruption Contract between the Shipper/Supplier and the DN Operator – both parties would hold copies of this revised contract. The DN may agree to the redesignation as a consequence of a number of factors such as a change in the demand on the network, completion of network re-enforcement etc. The DN Operator would then notify xoserve by file, and xoserve would update the Contract Management screens within UK Link (not visible to external parties). It is felt that the fact that both contracting parties have been party to the negotiation of changes to the contract should provide the means for Shippers/Suppliers to know that the contract has been altered.

Further to the subsequent discussion at UK Link Committee regarding the nomination referral and confirmation process, a time line has been provided to describe the process.
