## Proposed Implementation Workshop

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- Implementation of EU Codes means that 2015 will be a year of substantial change for the Industry
  - Gas day change
  - New IP capacity booking process
  - New IP nominations process
  - New IP allocations regime
  - Associated systems and procedure changes
- Taking this into account, would further information on delivery of the EU Phase 2 project / discussion on 'how it all fits together' be welcomed by the Industry?

## Proposed Implementation Workshop

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- If the Industry is in agreement, National Grid NTS proposes to hold a full day workshop open to all industry participants
- The agenda could include:
  - Summary of EU-driven UNC Modifications and the links between them
  - ‘A day in the life of an IP shipper’
    - From capacity booking to allocation
  - NG and shipper systems change requirements
  - Changes required to other agreements

## Proposed Implementation Workshop

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- Would the Industry welcome such a session? If so:
  - Is our proposed agenda sufficient?
  - What areas should we should focus on?
  - What else should be included?
- Timing: mid-late January 2015
- Location: NG preference is for Warwick because:
  - Conference facilities are available; and
  - A tour of our new National Control Centre could be incorporated
