## Holiday Code Rules: Background

- September 2010 DESC agreed a new set of holiday code rules to be used in Spring 2011 modelling.
- Application of these rules and subsequent derived Annual Load Profiles for gas year 2011/12 were discussed at the July DESC meeting in response to representations.
- Transporters agreed to amend 2011/12 ALP profiles as per discussions in July this option was referred to as "Option C" and was specific to gas year 2011/12.
- DESC also discussed how the standard holiday code rules could be changed for next years modelling.
- Following slide summarises those discussions - changes from existing rules are marked in red.
- Seek DESC agreement for use in Spring 2012 modelling


## Holiday Code Rules: Proposed rules for Spring 2012

- Start of Period: Monday before 25th December (but if 25th December falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, it starts on the Friday before 25th December).
- End of Period: First Friday on or after second Scotland New Year bank holiday.
- Holiday code 1: 25th December
- Holiday code 2: 26th December, January 1st and any remaining bank holidays (except second Scotland New Year bank holiday) and any other Saturdays and Sundays in the period.
- Holiday code 3: Any remaining Mondays to Fridays between 24th December and day before second Scotland New Year bank holiday inclusive
- Holiday code 4: Remaining days before 24th December
- Holiday code 5: Remaining days (will always include second Scotland New

Year bank holiday)

# Holiday Code Rules: Application to Christmas and New Year 2012/13 

Demonstration - Christmas and New Year 2012/13


Start: Monday before 25th December (but if 25th December falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, it starts on the Friday before 25th December). End: First Friday on or after second Scotland New Year bank holiday.

| Holiday Code 1 | 1 | 25th December |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Holiday Code 2 | 2 | 26th December, January 1st and any remaining bank holidays (except second Scotland New Year bank holiday) and any other <br> Saturday and Sundays in the period. |
| Holiday Code 3 | 3 | Any remaining Mondays to Fridays between 24th December and day before second Scotland New Year bank holiday inclusive. |
| Holiday Code 4 | 4 | Remaining days before 24th December |
| Holiday Code 5 | 5 | Remaining days (will always include second Scotland New Year bank holiday). |

# Holiday Code Rules: Application to Christmas and New Year 2010/11 

## Demonstration - Christmas and New Year 201011



Start: Monday before 25th December (but if 25th December falls on a Mbnday, Tuesday or Wednesday, it starts on the Friday before 25th December). End: First Friday on or after second Scotland New Year bank holiday.

| Holiday Code 1 | 1 | 25th December |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Holiday Code 2 | 2 | 26th December, January 1st and any remaining bank holidays (except second Scotland New Year bank holiday) and any other Saturday <br> and Sundays in the period. |
| Holiday Code 3 | 3 | Any remaining Mondays to Fridays between 24th December and day before second Scotland New Year bank holiday inclusive. |
| Holiday Code 4 | 4 | Remaining days before 24th December |
| Holiday Code 5 | 5 | Remaining days (will always include second Scotland New Year bank holiday). |
