0586: Resolution of Minor Legal Text Drafting Conflicts Arising from UNC Modification 0432

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## Why Change?

- The updating of UNC with Modification 0432 Legal Text as written, would result in sections of Code being unclear because of a number of minor numbering, formatting and consistency related conflicts
- In general, these have arisen due to the consequential effects of delay in implementation of Project Nexus
- In February 2016, the Joint Office (JO) concluded an exercise to determine the impact in relation to the UNC. This resulted in a number of potential Code references being highlighted as being in conflict preventing inclusion into UNC
- National Grid Gas Distribution, working closely with the JO, identified and investigated all relevant conflicts and produced a schedule of required changes to Legal Text and numbering which can be seen in the document Output from PN LT Tracker. Clear updating instructions have been provided



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#### • Mod 0432 TPD Section E 1.5.3

- In respect of each DM<u>Class 1 or 2</u> Supply Meter Point, the "Supply Meter Point Daily Quantity" is the quantity of gas (being the Metered Quantity) determined as offtaken from the Total System at the Supply Meter Point on a Day in accordance with Section M<u>Section M</u>.
- Mod 0428 TPD Section E 1.5.3
  - In respect of each DM Supply Meter Point, the "Supply Meter Point Daily Quantity" is the quantity of gas (being the Metered Quantity) determined as offtaken from the Total System at the Supply Meter Point on a Day in accordance with Section M.
- Outcome: Conflict 0428 deletes "Meter", but 0432 puts it back in; Amend as:
  - In respect of each Class 1 or 2 Supply Point, the "Supply Meter Point Daily Quantity" is the quantity of gas (being the Metered Quantity) determined as offtaken from the Total System at the Supply Point on a Day in accordance with Section M.
  - Red: Delete
  - Blue Underlined: Insert





#### Mad 0440 TDD Section D

- Mod 0440 TPD Section B 1.14
  - Mod 0440 (Project Nexus IGT Single Service Provision) will insert a new paragraph at 1.14 (through to 1.14.3)
- Mod 0465V TPD Section B 1.14
  - Mod 0465V (Introduction of the Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (PARCA), Weighted Average PARCA Security) has inserted a number of paragraphs at 1.14 (through to 1.18), but these are already live in Code.
- Outcome: Conflict Mod 0440 is attempting to insert a new paragraph where one previously exists
  - As Legal Text from 0465V is live in Code, insert Mod 0440 paragraphs from 1.19 (through to 1.19.3)





# **Solution**

- This modification seeks to resolve identified conflicts within Project Nexus related Legal Text which are highlighted in the Project Nexus Legal Text Tracker
- The separate Output from PN LT Tracker details the required numbering, text and formatting changes required
- Whilst not part of the Modification Proposal, a 'lock down' date of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 has been identified. This is a process step for Transporters as the providers of Legal Text as described below:
  - In the event modifications are proposed to be implemented in the period between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 and Project Nexus Implementation Date (PNID), then where necessary Transporters would produce 2 instances of text. This will show the impact on the live Code and on the 'to be' Code post PNID
    - 1st July to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2016 Transitional text in Code (with Enduring should this be relevant)
    - 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016 onwards Enduring text in Code



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### **Recommended Steps**

- The Proposer invites the Panel to determine that this modification should:
  - be subject to self-governance; and
  - follow fast track procedures and be implemented
    - as fast track self-governance procedures are proposed, implementation could be 16 business days after a unanimous vote in favour of implementation by the Modification Panel, subject to no objection being raised.
