MP/891/DA - Part 02 - New Rejection Reason Code for DN Interruption Auction

Currently for the DN Interruption auction, UKLink allows some bids to be amended when they have previously been cancelled. UKLink should be rejecting such amendments to cancelled bids. It is our intention to introduce a new rejection reason: 'Cancelled bid cannot be amended', which will appear within the S72 record type in the RFS File (Response File to Shipper).

We are seeking approval from the UKLink Committee that this rejection code can be introduced, such that it may be issued to users by the start of the DN Interruption Annual bid window, which runs from $1 - 12^{th}$ June 2009. The UKLink Committee meeting are asked to note that this does not allow for sufficient notice periods as detailed in Section U of the UNC and representations are asked to specifically consider this point, in particular comments are invited regarding waiving this notice period.

This matter will be discussed and approval sought at the April UKLink Committee meeting.

Subject Publication of Draft UKLink Implementation Summary in support of UNC Modification 224 for : Review

Dear Colleague,

The draft 'UKLink Implementation Summary' for UNC Modification 224 is available on the Joint Office website at: http://www.gasgovernance.com/Code/Workstreams/DistributionWorkstream/2009/

This document provides an initial view of the new and impacted UKLink file formats for this change. This document was discussed at the UNC Modification 224 Development Workgroup, and was agreed that members would solicit relevant inputs from within their organisation, and that this should not be issued to the UKLink Committee meeting at this time. This document was issued to the UKLink Committee distribution list in error, but a retraction has since been issued.

This change is a tactical solution, and where possible we have reused existing file formats. Some of these formats are used by the existing Daily Metered Service Providers (DMSP) to communicate with xoserve, so may look inconsistent to the existing formats. As discussed at the meeting, I would particularly welcome comment on the following subject areas:

- DME file / O10 record. This format is a clone of the existing input readings received from the DMSP.
- Users are asked specifically to note that the start and end readings are mandatory, therefore on transfer the Opening Reading is not expected until the following day. i.e. the start reading of the input file provided on D+I (where D is the confirmation effective date) will be the reading taken on D, and the reading taken on D+I will be the end reading.
 - The reading date in this file should be populated with the relevant Gas Flow Day date e.g. a reading record provided on 01/01/2009 would contain readings for Gas Flow Day 31/12/2008 the start reading would be that taken at 6am on 31/12/2008; and the end reading would be that taken at 6am on 01/01/2009.
 - 2 The reading protocol is that this should be to the lowest reading unit for example, where a meter reads in cubic feet this typically might have a read unit of

100 – i.e. that the readable dials register every hundred ft $^{\circ}$. On a 5 dial meter the NDM read register would therefore show 01234, the equivalent DM reading expected within the DME file would be 0123400.

- · RPA file / O02 and M01/S72 records. This format is an amended version of the existing rejection response file issued to the DMSP. This file will provide only rejections (accepted records will appear in a separate MDE file). Users are asked to note the following:
- · Where a **record** has reached the application and is processed, a rejection will be issued on the O02. The rejection reason will be embedded within this record, and will not be contained within the standard S72 rejection record appended beneath the erroneous record.
 - I Where a **file** has been rejected specifically because it has breached the maximum number of files within a day cap (this value is currently set at 10 in the requirements), this file shall be rejected using the M01 record, with a subordinate S72 record, providing the relevant rejection reason.
- DMO file / Various 'O' prefixed records. This is a new file for the additional level service. Embedded within this response record is the outcome code to indicate whether the record was accepted or rejected. The outcome is not indicated by an alternative record type.

As discussed at the 224 Development Group User comments are invited by Tuesday 24th February, so that these can be discussed at the 224 discussions that follow the Distribution Workstream on 26th February.
