3. Completion of Workgroup Report

During a brief onscreen review of the draft Workgroup Report (v1.1, dated 19 March 2014) it was noted that the cost range should read as '£400,000 - £650,000' and not '£400,000 - £900,000' as currently written.

Whilst reviewing the legal text, CW advised that the critical dates had now been included but did recognise that the term '[National Grid]' at the start of paragraph 4.1 in Annex A, Part 14 would need to be amended.

In considering the costs involved, AM confirmed that these would be attributed as defined within the approved ACS (i.e. calculated from data provided by number of MPR's across all iGT Networks).

Moving on to consider Section 5 – Implementation, AM advised that this is expected to be prior to Project Nexus delivery and would be defined by Transporters in due course.

When asked, CW confirmed that he would provide an amended modification proposal to reflect discussions asap.

Subject to the receipt of the agreed amendments to the modification, the Workgroup agreed the report should be submitted to the 19 June 2014 Panel for its consideration.
