### **1.0 Review of Minutes and Actions**

#### 1.1. Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

#### 1.2. Actions

**0301:** National Grid Distribution to consider whether the pre-Nexus meter reading needs to be carried forward into the UNC.

**Update:** MF clarified that at the previous meeting Colette Baldwin enquired about introducing a new defined term into the UNC relating to a pre Nexus meter reading. CW explained there is a need for a new defined term to allow for a Back Stop date and this is included in this modification. CW concluded the pre-Nexus meter reading definition will be required. **Closed.** 

#### 2.0 Consideration of Legal Text

CW explained there is a minor amendment required to remove a set of square brackets in the legal text. He confirmed that this will be updated and re-submitted to the Joint Office

for publication within the Workgroup Report. He beleived that this simple change should not hold up the completion of the Workgroup Report.

BF confirmed that a Legal Text Review Meeting has been planned on 27 April 2015 to explain how the text will work for the group of transitional modifications.

The Workgroup agreed that the Workgroup Report should be concluded.

#### 3.0 Development of Workgroup Report

The Workgroup agreed the modication was not a Self-Governance Modification.

MJ enquired about the solution and the tolerance changes for a more up to date reading amendment process. EL explianed that Shippers need to ensure that meter reads are loaded into UK Link to enable the use of the Spec Calcluation Process.

MJ was concerned that the use of a Back Stop date would possibly exclude good data being provided between the Backstop Date and Project Nexus Implementation Date. However, the value of such data was challenged if adjustments and corrections are being made which triggers the Back Stop Date. HC highlighted that the industry needs some protection from erroneous corrections.

MF enquired how the industry will have visibility of the actual Back Stop Date. ES confirmed the information is included in one of the AQ file flows. DA confirmed that the T04 file would provide the Back Stop date following an attempted or actual AQ Calculation.

DA suggested that once Shippers have submitted reads a large proportion of Back Stop dates will be provided under the current file formats. He confirmed that the Back Stop date will be communicated to users via the T04 file following the acceptance of the first meter reading into UK Link systems following the Project Nexus Implementation Date.

#### 4.0 Next Steps

The Workgroup Report was conculded for submision to the April Panel Meeting. No further meetings were planned.

#### 5.0 Any Other Business
