4.1 Sub Group Monitor Report

RJ explained the existence of the Sub Cap monitor. He highlighted differences that had been identified within the monitor and the UNC, it was recognised two of the sub caps values within the report were not in line with the values within the UNC due to changes in UNC provided services.

RJ proposed that sub cap J and L are updated. He provided a presentation to illustrate the changes proposed. The workgroup agreed in principle to this approach.

AR explained that some of the legacy arrangements for meter asset details have been kept alive and reported against. However, some of these arrangements need to be looked at with a view to removing them from the liability regime, as they are aspects of the metering regime. AR asked what the standards were and what the payments relate to. RJ agreed to provide National Grid Distribution with details of what feeds into the standards and what causes the liabilities, to enable further consideration and possible removal from the report.
