#### 2.1. Minutes

# 2.2. Actions

#### DTW0502:

**a)** DESC and Xoserve to work together to look at ways to enhance the current data sets with a target to have additional data for October.

**Update:** CI and SB confirmed amended data sets had been provided to Xoserve for review and analysis. FC requested that this action be considered further at the January meeting, so that lessons can be learned with an update provided to other Users who may want to provide aid for future analysis activities.

CI asked if it would be possible to circulate to a wider circulation list to allow other Users the opportunity to take part.

FC agreed to draft an email when the next similar action is ready to commence. **Carried Forward**.

**New Action DE1201:** FC to prepare an email for circulation to the industry inviting parties to support DESC Technical Workgroup analysis and data sets, if the use of shipper data in the autumn validation exercise is a success.

#### 3. Seasonal Normal Review

FC referred to the <u>Final Approach to Seasonal Normal Basis 2015</u> document, which had been updated with the agreed approach to derivation of the Seasonal Normal basis from October 2015 onwards.

This had been applied in the Seasonal Normal calculations, which had been reviewed at the earlier Technical Workgroup meeting and were now recommended for approval by DESC.

Referring back to the recent CWV Optimisation exercise, CI wanted to know how many models were used for each LDZ. JL explained that they didn't use a specific number of models but considered scenarios and adjusted parameters to find the optimum values that 'fitted' the best on average against the LDZ aggregate NDM demand

Members unanimously agreed to apply the recommendations of TWG that the proposed Seasonal Normal calculations are adopted, following a period of time to allow industry participants to provide comments.

## 4. Next Steps

FC agreed to prepare a communication to be issued to the wider industry during week commencing 08 December 2014, welcoming views on the final Seasonal Normal Composite Weather Variable (SNCWV) values, with comments to be received no later than 12 December 2014.

A DESC teleconference has been scheduled for 17 December 2014 to discuss any comments received and finalise the SNCWVs for use in AQ calculations and Demand Estimation modeling.

DESC Members agreed the following workplan:

January to March 2015:

Spring 2014 NDM analysis reworked using new CWVs and SNCWVs

Back-runs of individual years' EUC models using new CWVs and SNCWVs required for spring 2015 NDM analysis

Produce revised WAALPs for all EUCs from 01/10/2011 onwards using new CWVs and SNCWVs – required for 2015 AQ review

April to June 2015:

Spring 2015 NDM analysis (using new CWVs and SNCWVs)

Continue with off-line production of revised WAALPs
