# 3.2 ISS 053 Options for the provision of legal text

AR advised that a number of concerns had been raised by their legal team regarding as and when text is produced and funded. This would require a modification to progress alternative options for its provision and place costs where they were incurred.

PB was concerned about charging for the provision of text— should the service be contestable or centrally provided as the timely provision or quality of text was a concern for shippers. CB was concerned that this could lead to a duplication of costs as Transporters would still want to check the text before it is implemented.

JF advised that Transporters used to provide text at the request of Ofgem, whereas now the provision of text is for every modification and in multiple versions, which adds to the costs and delay.

CWr asked if the issue was due to the changes following the code governance review and the way they changed the provision of text.
