BF explained that due to the somewhat focused nature of the meeting (developing the draft Workgroup Reports), an abridged item 3 had been proposed which serves to focus on the raising of any new issues.

4. Any Other Business

<u>Industry 'Go-Live' Engagement and suggestion of a Proposed AQ Amendment Process change</u>

AM provided a brief overview of the current AQ amendment process arrangements following the implementation of modification 0292. AM explaining that at the implementation of modification 0432 the AQ amendment process ceases to exist. AM advised that some 53,000 smaller supply points have been subject to an AQ change without reads being loaded to S&M – the reads are submitted as part of the AQ amendment process but these reads do not load to S&M. AM considered asset record discrepancies were responsible for this behaviour. AM asked for views on whether or not parties would support increasing the AQ tolerance back up to 20% for 2014 (i.e. pre mod 0292) and then removing the AQ amendments process (for SSP's only) for 2015 thus creating an incentive for shippers to submit reads to the system and ensure that following implementation of modification 0432 AQ and reconciliations would have a good history of reads for use. AM considered this suggestion was unlikely to receive much support but it was still worth raising. Participants agreed to consider this option but would want more time to consider the impacts.

Cost of Energy (unallocated gas) consideration

When asked, AM confirmed that consideration of this matter had been undertaken (and recorded) during the development of the various BRD's.

Short Notice Material Provision for forthcoming Project Nexus Meetings

BF explained that due to the increased frequency of the forthcoming Project Nexus meetings, it would no longer be possible to provide either notification of, or materials for, the meetings in accordance with the requirements defined within the Code of Practice.
