#### Shippers Initiating an Amendment to an IA

To address Shippers concerns with IAs, National Grid NTS is proposing the following:

- A Shipper may raise a notification relating to Relevant Interconnection Provisions where they are being adversely affected
- National Grid NTS will within 30 business days of receiving the notification respond by:
  - a) Proposing an amendment to the Adjacent TSO; or
  - b) Reply setting out why it does not consider it appropriate to propose an amendment; or
  - c) Invite the Shipper to discuss the issue further and within 30 business days carry out a or b

### **Liability Provision (1)**

- Feedback from Shippers
  - 1) Clause was not sufficiently specific and therefore too general; and
  - 2) There was no scope for resolution of TSO errors, related to the new IA processes e.g. matching regime
- In response to the feedback we are proposing a two part solution
  - 1) Identify clearly what the TSOs are seeking indemnity from i.e.:
    - Capacity bundling;
    - Matching or allocation provisions;
    - Accepting delivery of gas or making gas available for offtake; and
    - Gas complying with specification at the IP



### **Liability Provision (2)**

- 2) Error correction by TSOs
  - Where a TSO makes an error implementing the nominations and allocation matching processes
    - Shippers can request an error correction within Close Out timescales i.e. on or before D+5 to avoid impacting energy balancing
    - Nomination error attributable to the TSO may be rectified within day where possible
  - TSOs investigate and agree with all parties to a correction utilising a revised CNQ for allocation purposes
