Dear Colleague,

Further to the File Formats issued on 9th December 2005, xoserve propose a slight change to the Charge Type Code value shown within record H07 of the '.SUJ' file.

Following approval of the UKLink Implementation Plan it has been highlighted by Users that it would be preferable to provide a unique charge type code in the Sharing supporting information. We are at a stage within the development where this can be changed for the March 2006 implementation date agreed with the UKLink Committee. In the previous implementation plan it was proposed that the value '823' be introduced on the H07 record in the .SUJ file, and the H02 record in the .SUI file to represent Sharing and Incentive charge types, respectively.

We have been requested that a unique code be provided to differentiate between these charges from different origins so propose that the allowable value '824' be used on the H07 record to indicate charges generated from the Sharing functionality.

Following issue of communication NR/595/DD this matter was discussed at the UKLink Committee meeting on 9th February 2006, and we were requested to send this out for comment. Comments are invited from Users to be received by 24th February 2006.
