Solution & Cleanse approach

Solution to the issue

• An amendment is being made to the code, so that only the targeted address is amended via the monthly PAF update process.

Cleanse approach

- The entire set of addresses, as recorded on UK-Link, has been sent to our Address Management Service Provider.
- They will compare these addresses against their source database.
- All addresses that wholly match will not be updated. We will obtain visibility of these matched addresses.
- Addresses that require a correction (as described on slide 5) will be auto updated
- Some updates will be intercepted for manual attention if the 'target' address can't be determined



Estimated cleanse period

 Due to the approach there is likely to be more updates than originally forecast. To complete this activity the project is now estimating it will require 5 weeks to complete the cleanse.



Estimated volumes

- As a result of the issue we believe there will be circa 2 million (10%) updates due to addresses previously being erroneously updated.
- It is estimated that a further 10 million addresses will be updated as part of this matching exercise and they include:
 - Administrative Updates:
 - Removal of 0's in the House No. field (and in a few other places)
 - Missing or incorrect County details
 - The removal of fields with foreign characters
 - Correction to addresses which are misspelt and/or have abbreviations
 - Wrongly formatted addresses
 - Withheld monthly PAF updates

- Please note these are fictitious address details highlighting the types of updates you are likely to receive in addition to resolving the corruption.
- Please note the highlighted green fields indicate the updates that would be made as part of the 10 million updates.



Approach

- The project is currently in performance testing and the working assumption is the project will load no more than 500,000 records per day.
- We estimate you will receive a comparable number of updates to your % share of the market per day.

Options

Shipper options				
Option 1	Receive all updates on the NAC file which Xoserve make per day			
Option 2	Receive all the updates but the NAC files will not be all issued out on the same day Xoserve loads them in, some would be held so you receive them at a slower rate (than we load them in).			
Option 3 *	Receive no updates			
Option 4 *	Only receive the circa 2 million updates & receive them as we load them, exclude the circa 10 million updates			
Option 5 *	Only receive the circa 2 million updates (exclude the 10 million updates) but have the 2 million updates issued out on the NAC files at a slower rate than we load them.			

 Please note there is a risk associated to options highlighted with an * as; in addition to holding cleanse updates, additional updates not triggered as a result of the cleanse e.g. ADD updates, may also not be issued out to pertinent Shippers.
