SMIP Prospectus Response - Background

- Smart Metering Implementation Programme Prospectus issued jointly by DECC/Ofgem July 2010
- Large number of consultation questions –
 200 responses received
- Government decisions issued by DECC in "Response to Prospectus Consultation" March 2011
- Appropriate to review outcomes against current Project Nexus workplans

Relevant Points from Prospectus Response

- DCC processes to go-live Q2 2014
- Smart meter roll-out mandated from Q2 2014
- Initial scope of DCC is "thin" model secure comms and data retrieval
- "Meter point/supplier registration" will migrate to DCC later, probably 2-3 years later



Relevant Points from Prospectus Response (2)

- Use of DCC is optional for non-Domestic Smart meters
- Smaller suppliers can use existing flows where practical
- Target roll-out completion 2019
- Any further migration of functions would be much later – probably 2019



Assessment of Topic Areas

- Original Project Nexus Topic Areas were reviewed at December 2010 meeting
- Assessed as to whether covered by SMIP/ SCR/Project Nexus
- Assessment resulted in work starting on Smart meter Settlement
- Assessment has been updated following publication of Response
 - Significant Code Review not yet initiated by Ofgem
 - Red indicates changed assessment


