Hybrid approach to Requirements Development

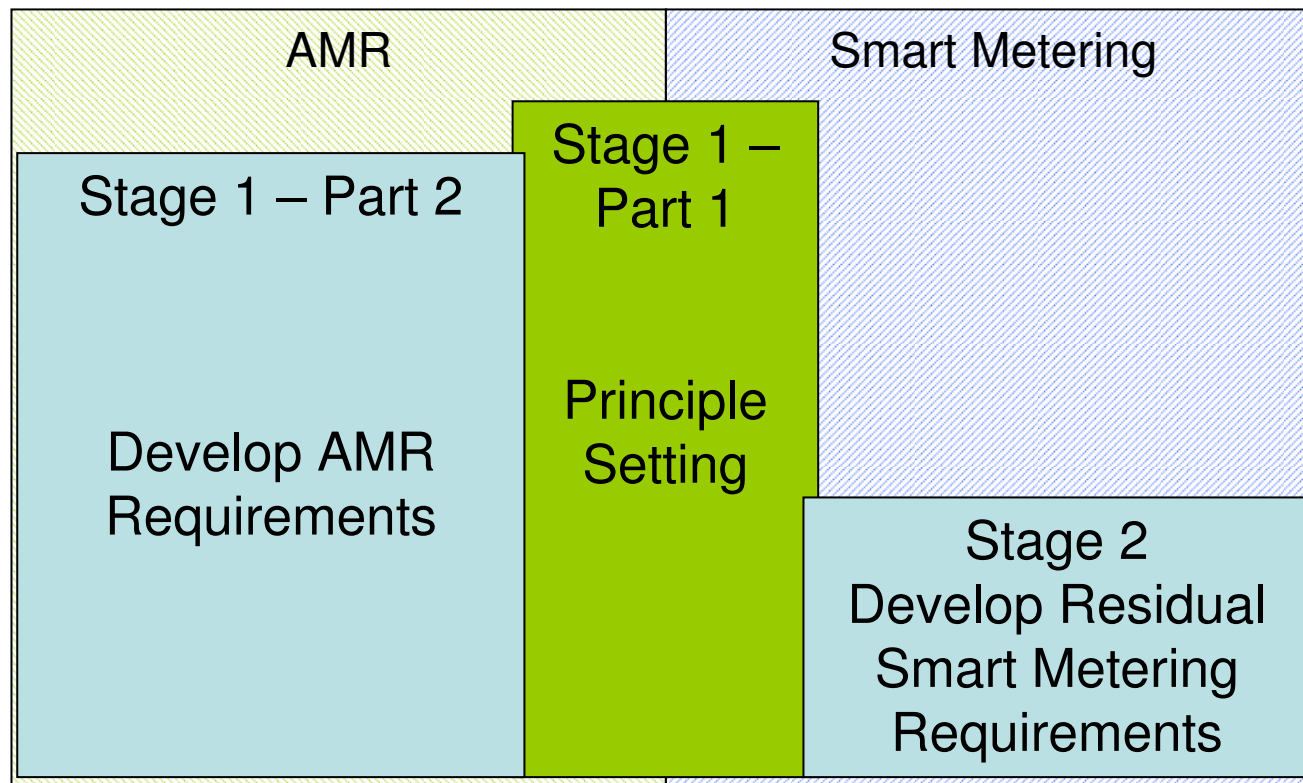

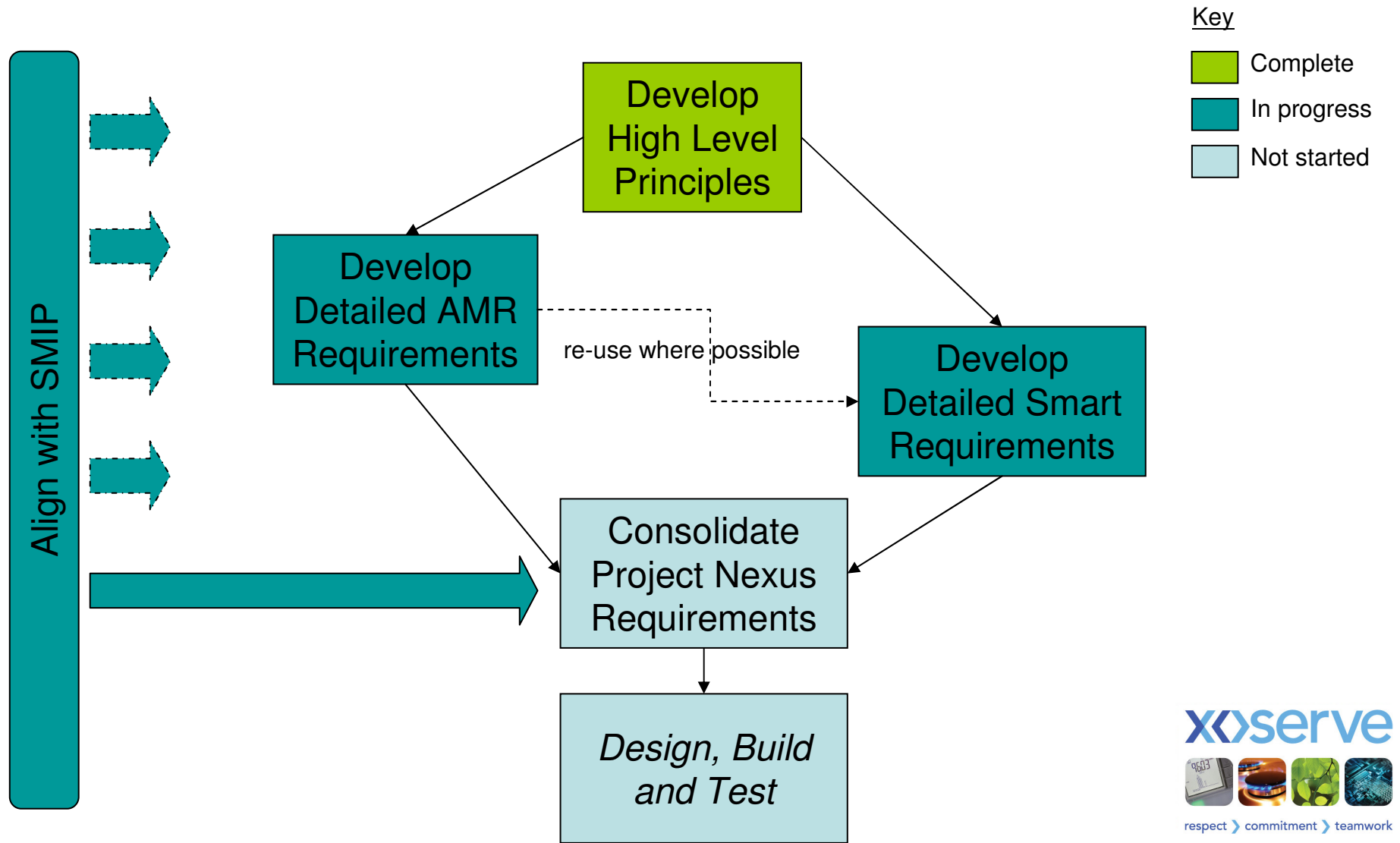
Background to the Hybrid Approach

- Options presented to PNAG October 2009
- Option b – Hybrid Approach was preferred option
- PNUNC adopted PNAG recommendation
- Approach was tailored to the different levels of certainty in different market sectors

Interaction between AMR & Settlement

- Overview of latest AMR requirements presented at Settlement 1
- Aim was to highlight differences from Principles, not to re-work AMR requirements
- Settlements will re-use work from AMR wherever possible

Hybrid Approach – Original Plan

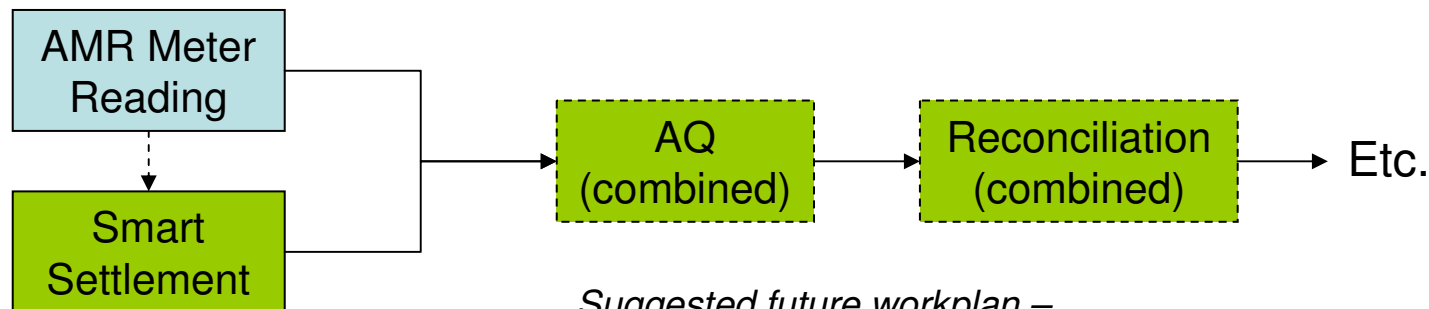


Original AMR Topic Workplan

- Meter Reading – nearly complete
- Resynch & Reconciliation – not started
- Supply Point Enquiry Service – nearly complete
- Market Differentiation (*may need to be done at industry level*)

Alternative Approaches

- Option A:
 - Complete work on AMR Meter Reading
 - Single discussion of Reconciliation in Smart/Domestic Workgroup following Settlement

- Option B:
 - Complete work on AMR Meter Reading
 - Continue only with topics which are specific to AMR
 - Resynchronisation of AMR to meter (derived read systems only)
