We presume that this could be populated in the column presently headed LDZ.	Clarification was sought via the Network Operator Representative for this change regarding the requirement to include the attribute 'GT name' in the CSEP dataset. Following clarification on the CSEP dataset (referenced in the SCOGES working group Business Requirements Specification documentation, v1.2 section 3.7.1, 1st Level 1) which includes 'LDZ id', it was confirmed that iGT's do not use this information. It was therefore agreed that a more pragmatic and cost effective approach would be for the field to remain visible as 'LDZ id' and for users to populate the CSEP operator name (id) in the 'LDZ id' field. In the event of a query, this will enable users of the service to recognise the provider of the information.
