We do support the principal of using email as a valid code communication within the UNC in order to issue general communication to all parties simultaneously.

Email may be considered easier to use, reliable, faster and efficient and a number of the proposed changes to the UK Link Manual are for general, non-User specific reports or processes. We believe that email should be considered as an appropriate form of communication in these cases.

However we have concerns where data or information to be sent relates to a specific User or site. Email as a form of communication will only be secure if the Gas Transporters and Xoserve ensure that the systems and processes are in place to manage the secure transmission of data.

UNC 0479S does not place an obligation on the Gas Transporter or Xoserve to ensure that there are appropriate safeguards to prevent one User's data or information from being issued in error to another User.
