RWEnpower understands the risk to the market that a Shipper who is not ready for Nexus go-live may present.

The independent expert will need to be significantly qualified to make a judgement decision on the ability of varying market participants to deliver their own projects. This includes the necessary experience and knowledge of how large scale transformational programmes are delivered, capabilities, milestones and signs of slippage. We believe that there is also a wider remit for the independent expert to show the impact of Nexus on a Shipper's ability to deliver broader converging industry changes such as the DCC go-live.

The publication of a redacted report may drive incorrect behaviour from Shippers who believe a delay is likely, caused by another shipper.

A complete picture of the industry is required, this proposal does not include any assessment of the ability of the Transporter's agent to deliver the project and the project milestones in a timely manner which in turn has a corresponding impact on Shippers. Whilst an overview of project Nexus and its progress is provided to the Gas Change Overview Board we believe it would benefit from independent assessment by a third party.

This modification does not detail any action to be taken if a Shipper is found not to be sufficiently prepared for Nexus which further highlights the current lack of contingency arrangements or fall back plan in the programme.
