# **UNC Mod<sup>n</sup> 0613S - Revised UK Link Manual CDSP Data Services Document**

- Challenges regarding the approach to amending the UK Link Manual
  - DSC Contract Management Committee challenged the need for a UNC Mod<sup>n</sup>
    - Proposed that UK Link Terms and Conditions and UK Link Manual Framework Document be reviewed by DSC CoMC
    - Recommended that the UK Link Manual Component Documents be reviewed by DSC Change Management Committee
  - Lack of time to review given other industry changes

# Approach

- Modification is necessary as there will be changes to “Code Level Provisions” and these can only be amended by a Code Modification. Code Level Provisions include:
  - UK Link Terms and Conditions
  - UK Link Manual Framework Document
  - Potentially other UKLM Components Documents
    - E.g. Code Communications Reference Document; Other References
- A single transparent process for the review of the whole UK Link Manual under the Modification process will ensure that any such changes go through the correct governance

# Engagement

- Noting comments, revised approach is proposed
  - Component Documents (excl. UKLM T&Cs; UKLM FD)
    - Provide documents to DSC Change Management Committee for representation cycle and review. ChMC will not be required to approve
    - Documents have been issued to ChMC distribution lists in 4 tranches starting 1<sup>st</sup> May, concluding 19<sup>th</sup> May
    - Discuss documents at June and July ChMC as dictated by representation cycle
    - Consolidate Component Documents back into 0613 WG Report so that we can ensure consistency against the UK Link Terms and Conditions and the UK Link Manual Framework Document and the workgroup report contains a full package of related documents
  - UKLM Terms and Conditions and UKLM Framework Document
    - Considered through 0613 WG on 5<sup>th</sup> June
    - Documents available on JO since 19<sup>th</sup> May
    - Incorporation into single 0613 WG report following July ChMC will extend report timescales

- Conclusion
  - Component Documents are available
    - Documents will be discussed at June and July ChMC as dictated by representation cycle
  - 0613 JO meetings will consider UKLM Terms and Conditions and UKLM Framework Document – proposed on 5<sup>th</sup> June
    - Please review and consider representation for this meeting. You may wish to seek legal views.
  - Incorporation into single 0613 WG report following July ChMC will extend report timescales beyond June report date – date to be agreed
