# Supply Point Class Change to Class 2

# Background

- Action NEX0602 from 4<sup>th</sup> June PN UNC requested Xoserve to provide an explanation for how a Confirmation of a Supply Point to Class 2 would work
- A detailed process map will be included in the ‘To be processes’ under Class changes
- The following 2 slides provides an overview of the process
  - From Class 3 or 4 to Class 2
  - From Class 1 to Class 2

# Transfer from Class 3 or 4 to Class 2 (no change in the Registered Shipper)

- Shipper can either submit a
  - Supply Point Confirmation requiring [8] (Mod 477 changes timescale) business days notice or
  - Supply Point Amendment requiring a minimum of 5 business days notice
- If the Supply Point Amendment route is used, the Shipper must provide the existing SOQ for the Supply Point (SOQ derived from the AQ for the NDM Supply Meter Point) and an SHQ within acceptable ratio of SOQ.
  - The Shipper can then submit a Supply Point Capacity change request (SPC) after the Class change has gone live, this will result in a Referral to the Network
- If the Shipper chooses to use the Confirmation process a Capacity change can be requested at the same time

# Transfer from Class 1 to Class 2 (no change in the Registered Shipper)

- Same as a change from Class 3 or 4 except:
  - The DMSP will need to carry out a Check Read to close out the period of Class 1
    - where the reads are being derived by the GTs Daily Read Equipment
  - The Shippers daily read submitted for the Class change date will be used as the first Check Read
    - and the subsequent Check Read will reconcile back to the preceding Check Read on the Class change date
