There would be one file for XFTM (as per current process) and 1 for EFT.</p> <p>The format of both log files would be exactly the same with the new log file being placed in the same location as the existing log file with a different file name.</p>

We will have to make a change to our file handler to accept the new log types, so we ask Xoserve provide details to the committee for the new log structure and where the logs will be dropped into (existing and old) as soon as possible.
