

Public Consultation on the Initial Draft TAR NC starts on 30th May

Initial Draft TAR NC Consultation closes on 30th July

Refinement Workshop on the 24th of September Submission of the refined draft TAR NC to ACER by the 31st of December













Consultation Workshop in Brussels on 25th June ENTSOG analyses responses to consultation on the Initial Draft TAR NC Stakeholder Support Process (SSP) 7th-21st of November

Draft Tariff Code

- Key deviations from FG:
 - Chapter II (Cost Allocation Approach) flexibility regards to possible tariff setting in common and the inclusion of the asset allocation methodology.
 - Chapter IV (Reserve Prices) possibility to have multipliers higher than 1.5 and to have the pricing for all interruptible products based on the probability of interruption (not the pricing of some products based on marginal costs).
 - Chapter VII (Payable Price) reflects the possibility to have fixed price contracts.

Chapter I – General Provisions

- Transmission services definition
 - > Allows for short-haul as "dedicated service"

Chapter II – Cost Allocation Approach

- 5th Cost Allocation Methodology asset allocation methodology
- Inclusion of compromise text for possible common tariff setting
- Allows existing GB approach + allows "discount" of tariff at storage facilities

Initial Draft Tariff NC

Chapter III – Publication Requirements

- In line with the TAR FG
- Harmonisation of tariff period open for consultation

Chapter IV – Reserve Prices (IPs only)

- Safeguard to allow multipliers higher than 1.5
- Same approach to pricing for all interruptible capacity products
- > Ex-post discount on interruptible allowed

- In line with the TAR FG
 - > Impact of "single regulatory account" on GB?

Chapter VI – Pricing of Bundled Capacity and Capacity for VIPs (IPs only)

> Fixed price option

Chapter VIII – Incremental and New Capacity (IPs only)

- > Fixed price option
- In case Economic Test cannot be passed at reserve prices then possibility to adjust tariff or depreciation rate
