

User Pays Invoicing Proposal for a Standardised Single Supporting Information File Format

Background

- Charges associated with Type 1 (UNC) User Pays services are issued via the IX via a single Adhoc invoice (.ADH) per Shipper on a monthly basis
- This includes charges for:
 - Must Reads, Shipper Agreed Reads, USRV's, DME, AUGE Charges and Meter Read Asset Report
- The associated invoice supporting information (SI) for User Pays charges is issued via email to Shipper operational contacts
 - Shippers receive one supporting information file per service line
 - SI enable's Shippers to validate charges
- The SI received includes multiple file formats (.xls, .csv), structures and content
- Data is diverse and there are limited common elements in each SI file due to the varied services



Background - Current Initiatives: ADW

- Xoserve are currently reviewing the Adhoc invoicing process, specifically the associated charge types, SI file formats and how SI is issued
- With the increase in the number of User Pays services in the last 12 months (DME, MOD279, MOD229 / 317), focus has been given to the User Pays Adhoc invoicing process
- As previously discussed at UK Link Committee this review has initially resulted in the creation of the Adhoc ADW invoice type (within the .ADH invoice) specifically for all User Pays charge types
 - MOD229 / 317 & MOD279 charges have been created using ADW
 - The intention is to transfer all other current User Pays charge types from ADN (a 'generic' Adhoc charge type) to ADW
 - All new User Pays charge types will be created using ADW

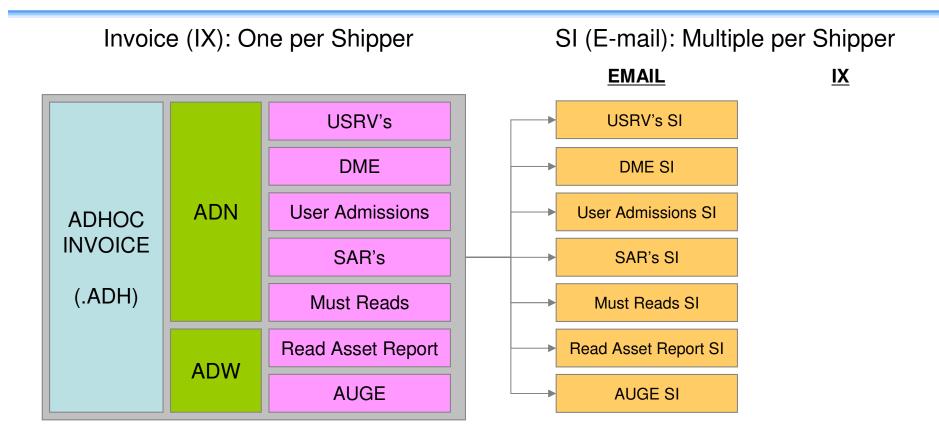


Background - Current Initiatives: SI Review

• Note: The Adhoc invoice can also incorporate other Adhoc invoice types & charge types however the User Pays adhoc invoice will only include the above.



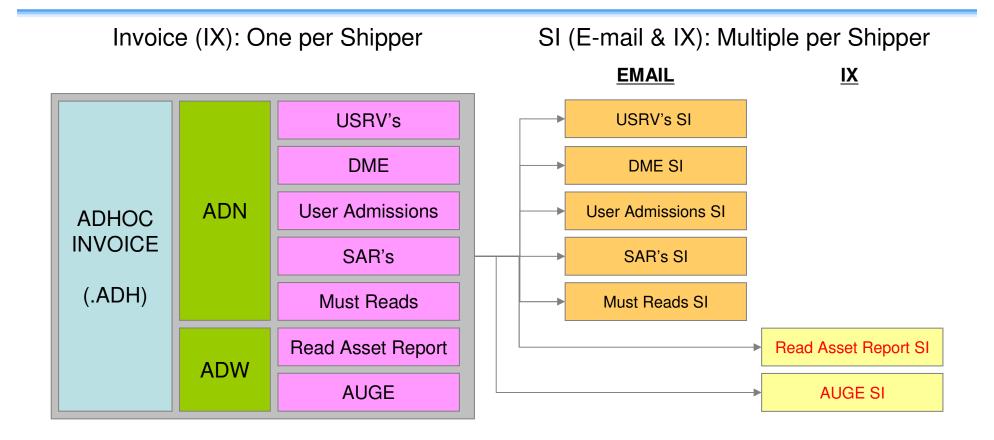

User Pays Adhoc Invoicing: Transitional Process (1)

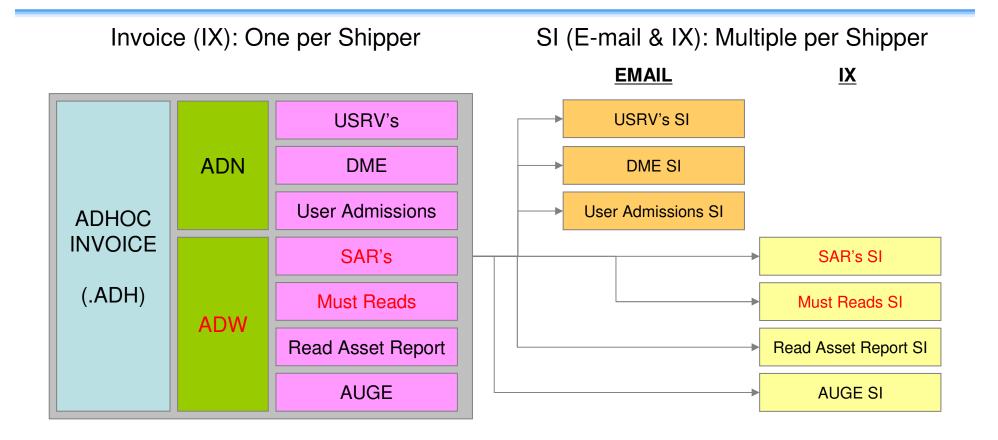


Services associated to ADW SI to be sent via IX and not email

Proposed Enabling Strategy: New User Pays Services

- New User Pays services / charges will be set up utilising ADW invoice type
 - MOD279 Read Asset History Report & MOD229 / 317 AUGE first to utilise
- A standardised file format that will be suitable to send via the IX will be developed for each new service line
 - A proposed format has been issued for MOD279 & MOD229 / 317 (provided)
 - Contains common 'elements' that will support a future single SI file format
 - Standard Header
 - Standard Invoice Summary
 - Standard Charge Type Summary
 - Service Charge Type Detail Record/s
 - Standard Trailer
- All new service charges SI to be sent via IX (no transitional period)
 following relevant industry agreement / notification
- Note MOD279 & MOD 229 / 317 SI to be issued via email initially until agreement and industry notification is concluded

Proposed Enabling Strategy: Current User Pays Services

- For <u>current User Pays service charges</u> associated to ADN invoice type:
 - Stage 1 New charge types will be set up and subsequent invoicing will be done using ADW
 - Stage 2 New file formats will be developed that are IX suitable, incorporating the same 'common' / standardised structure as the new services / charges previosuly discussed
 - Change therefore will only be associated to the detail record
 - Changes to data items should be minimal (based on current SI)
 - Continue to send via email <u>if required</u> until Stage 3
 - Stage 3 Following industry agreement and notification, files will subsequently be issued via the IX
- Changes to the current service charge types will be determined by either other changes associated with the services or targeted projects
- Once all services are ADW and utilising 'common' file format
- Propose a single SI file is issued incorporating all charges

Points for Consideration

- Proposal that is seeking discussion / direction / support from the industry
- Each change will be presented to the UK Link Committee and agreement sought including the relevant notification timescales
- Time to transfer current service charges to a common file format and issue via the IX will be required for both xoserve and Shippers
 - Multiple systems creating SI data, dispersed systems, time requirements to amend systems and produce (and accept) SI files
 - Move to a single SI file will take time envisage shippers will continue to receive multiple individual SI files for some time but also receive some files via IX and some via email for the immediate future



Points For Consideration cont.

- In regards to the common file format:
 - MOD279 and MOD229 / 317 have been created with this proposal in mind
 - Standardised Header / Invoice Type Summary / Charge Type Summary / Trailer
 - Unique / Individual detail record/s specific to the service charge
 - Where possible, new record types (i.e. detail records) will only be created if required – current detail record types will be utilised wherever possible
 - E.G. For MOD279, record type R11 will be amended to be a generic User Pays report SI detail record (change title and include a report name)
 - Envisage that the creation of single record type/s for multiple services will be difficult due to the diversity of the services provided and the data required for the SI
 - As illustrated at a high level...



Points For Consideration cont.

 Example: Diversity of SI data provided resulting in the requirement for individual detail records

Proposed Timescales for Notification

- If the proposal and standard file format is agreed:
- For New Services propose 1 months industry notification of file format and send via IX
 - New detail record/s will be required
 - Example: The AUGE invoice is due to be issued in August however confirmation from the industry regarding the calculation and invoicing method was not received until June
 - Contingency issue via email in the interim and later by IX
- For changes to current services propose 3 months notification
 - Envisage Shippers and Xoserve current systems / process will need to be changed
 - Data item changes will be kept to minimum unless they support the creation of a generic record type
- Welcome industry views on this

Proposed Timescales for Notification

Perceived Benefits

- The agreement for the creation of ADW allows clearer identification of specific charge types (responding to industry request for clearer identification of Adhoc charge types)
- A standardised, common SI file is envisaged to provide improved visibility and understanding of current and new file formats to the industry
- All SI files being sent via the IX rather than email improves security, reduces manual processing and administration and moves towards a single method rather than multiple processes
- A single SI file would reduce the volume of files being issued and received
- Ultimately creation of a single SI file for User Pays could be utilised for the creation of a similar single SI file for all Adhoc invoices

Possible Issues / Concerns

- Timescales to achieve
- Impact of changes to Xoserve and Shipper systems & processes
- Continuation of two different methods during the transition



Next Steps

- Request UK Link Committee review the proposal and identify any additional issues or options for further discussion
- Propose comments received in July UKLC meeting are considered, and incorporated into a communication to trigger the standard representation process
 - Communication to be sent following this meeting giving 10 days representation period for the principles covered in this presentation
 - Transfer of existing SI to IX from e-mail with reduced notice period (3 months)
 - Introduce new User Pays service lines with 1 month notice period and issued via the IX
 - Committee asked to note that the transition period is not a defined period changes will be undertaken as other changes are identified
 - If agreed Xoserve would be seeking to move MOD279, 229 / 317 and DME to the common file format and issue via the IX as soon as possible
 - Xoserve would then begin to schedule the change with other current service charge types and any new service charges
