## UNC User Representative Elections 2016 – SPoC Review email

Thank you for agreeing to be the Single Point of Contact (or alternate) for the recent Elections. Your support and timely actions were much appreciated and the process was relatively successful.

You will be aware that 2016 was the first year the JO operated the Election process for Panel, UNCC and its sub-committees. We committed to adding transparency whilst adopting much of the process we inherited from The Gas Forum, and this proved an effective strategy.

The number of SPoCs registering to vote was much higher than in recent years, which was a hugely encouraging sign, though ultimately this did not fully translate into an excess of candidates and only one election was required in the end. Several committees are not fully represented. We believe that having the broadest possible interest and participation in UNC matters is good for the industry as a whole; it relieves some of the pressure on the relatively few people who do provide a lot of their time; and it *demonstrates* effective governance.

We intend to consult widely on the improvements that could be made for the 2017 Election process and, as an input to this, we would appreciate your feedback on how the process ran for you this year. We want to keep this simple and make it as easy as possible for you to feedback; please find below a few topics, along with prompts that are intended to focus your views, along with the usual catchall at the end for anything else you would like to share with us. Please simply reply to this email and put your views in the spaces provided below each question **by 5pm on Friday 18 November 2016**.

We expect to issue a wider consultation, which will cover what you tell us and some of our own views, early in 2017 such that a revised process can be settled in good time for next year's elections.
