
The High Level Statistics

In total we received 30 responses to the DSR survey, these responses were from a variety of sectors including ceramics, chemicals, glass, iron, education, heat treatment, paper, construction and electronics.


- 80% of respondents answered either 'yes' or 'maybe' to participating in the DSR Mechanism if this helped protect their critical loads and they received compensation for doing so
- 66.7% of respondents said they would be willing to participate in a National Grid run expression of interest trial
- Over 80% of respondents left their contact details so National Grid could contact them for further information

Breakdown of responses to key questions


Approximately what is your average daily gas demand?
