Compliance	<ul> <li>The methodology that will be implemented will be compliant with the EU Tariffs Code</li> <li>We recognise there may be areas where compliance with aspects of the EU Tariff Code may require further discussion and clarification and potential updates</li> </ul>										
Delivery	<ul> <li>UNC0621 proposes a methodology to be in place to impact prices from 2019.</li> <li>The proposal acknowledges that it should deliver a methodology that provides a framework for changes and refinements beyond 2019</li> <li>To refine and update key parts of the proposed methodology over the short term</li> <li>There will be a number of ways this could be done and the modification will be updated appropriately</li> <li>To support the evolution of the charging regime</li> </ul>										

## Gas Charging Review: UNC0621 – Managing updates / Alternates

#### Plan for updating and amending UNC0621

- Modification proposal 0621 "Amendments to Gas Transmission Charging Regime". (version 1.0)
  - Draft amendments are being discussed today version 1.1
- If there are any further amendments we will table them in draft format first before formally amending the version on the Joint Office Website
- Alternative proposals may be raised until the completion of the Workgroup Report for Panel consideration.
- This deadline should be balanced against the need to develop any such alternative proposal and to produce legal text.
- Ideal to have early engagement of draft modification/s text, at the workgroup, before they are formally raised and enter into the loop of version control.
- Modification proposals with multiple alternative proposals past experience:
  - Desirable to avoid multiple versions for each proposal, particularly during the process of creating the legal text.

  - Responses due on or before 1 November 2017
