National Grid NTS believes that UNC Modification 0627s furthers the relevant objectives as outlined in the Draft Modification Report. In terms of Relevant objective (d) securing of effective competition (i) between relevant shippers, we believe that it is furthered in this case since the modification, if implemented, will facilitate cheaper and simplified connections and access to the NTS opening up potential to new entrants.
