Invitation to participate in the Adhoc Decrease of Enduring Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity at NTS Exit Points (ADEFLEC)

Due to receiving multiple Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (PARCA) applications an ADEFLEC application will be held for the first time.

Please note that all decrease application requests that are received within this application window, will be considered for reservation and future substitution regardless of any outstanding User Commitment.

Pursuant to Section B3.2.19 of the Transportation Principal Document (TPD) of the Uniform Network Code (UNC), National Grid Gas plc in its role as holder of the Gas Transportation Licence in respect of the National Transmission System (NTS) invites you to take part in the ADEFLEC at NTS Exit Points and submit a notice of reduction at any of the relevant NTS Exit Points below.

National Grid will conduct the ADEFLEC application on:

Monday 29th January 2018

The ADEFLEC application window will commence at 08:00 and close at 17:00 on the same calendar day.

The relevant NTS Exit Points to which we are inviting offers of enduring annual reductions are:

Where reductions are received and accepted, National Grid Gas plc will notify each User of the date on which the reduction is to be effective and the updated amount of Enduring Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity that User will continue to be registered as holding, by no later than 2nd February 2018 on Gemini Exit.

National Grid will, no later than twenty-four hours after giving effect to a notice of reduction publish on its website at: <http://mip-prod-web.azurewebsites.net/ExitCapacityPublication/Index> the following information in respect of each NTS Exit Point for where a notice of reduction was received in each case in accordance with UNC TPD B3.2.22 and the Exit Capacity Release methodology statement:-

- Aggregate amount of Enduring Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity for which Users gave notices of reduction.
- Aggregate amount of Enduring Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity which Users ceased to be registered as holding.
