#### 1.0 Introduction and Status Review

#### 1.1 Approval of Minutes (19 November 2018)

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

#### 2.0 Review of Amended Modification

John Welch (JW) advised that some amendments have been made to the modification, and the legal text provided has been reviewed. It was confirmed that there are some changes required to the Legal Test as the Proposer, JR, has some concerns regarding the link to Section H of Uniform Network Code. On reflection, JW suggested that he would prefer to define the characters of who the obligation links to rather than Section H. This is further discussed in agenda item 4.0.

#### **Joint Office** of Gas Transporters

#### 4.0 Review of Legal Text

The Workgroup reviewed the Legal Text that was provided dated 15 November 2018.

JW advised he had some queries in relation to section H and feels that, if in the future, DESC decides to change where the consumption applies to, because this is a linked obligation, specifying who would need to do this process is important for both transparency and visibility.

JW stated his preference was to add a definition of the supply points this would relate to.

To aid the discussion, notes were made on screen updating a copy of the Legal Text that was originally submitted together with a review of Section H, paragraph 1.8 and the minutes of the last meeting.

Subject to review by Legal, Paragraph 5.9.16 is now likely to read:

5.9.16 In respect of a Supply Point with AQ larger than 293,000 kWh Class 4, Smart or Advanced Supply Meter "winter consumption data" means [data which is required by the CDSP to enable it to determine the quantity of gas which is offtaken from the Total System at the Supply Meter Point in the period December to March in a Gas Year]. as a proportion of the [Annual Quantity] for the Supply Meter Point [prevailing at the start of such Gas Year].

Subject to review by Legal, Paragraph 5.9.17 is now likely to read:

5.9.17 Where the Registered User of a Supply Point with AQ larger than 293,000 kWh, Class 4, Smart Meter or Advanced Supply Meter is notified by the [PAFA CDSP] (pursuant to reporting undertaken as part of the Performance Assurance Scheme) in May in a Gas Year that Winter Consumption Data is not available in respect of the Supply Meter, the Registered User shall, [no earlier than

It was agreed that there also needs to be a reference to the alignment to the AQ Correction window date range that this will be applicable to, the suggested text was noted for Tracey Saunders (TS) to take back to her legal team:

-14 Supply Point Systems Business Days from 01 September and no later than -15 Supply Point Systems business days before 01 October

Workgroup agreed that all EUC bands above class 3 should be included in the Xoserve reports and the modification proposal will be updated to align with this agreement.

Consideration of the next meeting date (after January Panel) led to discussion of whether the workgroup report can be completed by t-con in the new year, once legal text has been received, in order that the Workgroup Report can be submitted to the January Panel.

#### **Next steps:**

- Joint Office are to request 1-month extension at UNC Panel on 20 December
- TS will provide the amended legal text
- Minor amendment to the modification is required
