#### 1. Introduction and Status Review

#### 1.1. Approval of Minutes (24 June 2019)

The minutes from the previous meetings were approved.

#### 2. Consideration of Amended Modification

Fiona Cottam (FC) explained that there had been minimal alterations to the Modification in relation to Code obligations, with the main change being the inclusion of Class 2. She added that, given the Modification Panel's decision to reschedule the presentation of the Workgroup Report, the timetable in the proposal would also need to be updated. FC then provided an overview of the amendments and highlighted specific areas of importance.

A brief general discussion took place in relation to the requirements and it was agreed the present way in which this was presented in the Proposal was framed around the existing UNC drafting in G1.6.15 and could be better presented with stand-alone requirements. Alan Raper (AR) suggested that a pictorial illustration of the rules in G1.6.15 would provide further clarity and enhance the understanding of how the Modification would operate in practice. He then presented a graphic to show the affected UNC text and all agreed this was useful and helpful. FC agreed to amend the Modification to state the specific requirements of Class 1 threshold crossers, which in any event would need to be explicit & discrete, since the proposal did not propose that supply points crossing other thresholds would be captured by this proposal.

**New Action 0701:** Xoserve (FC) to provide a pictorial illustration of the threshold crossing rules for different Class categories.

#### 3. Consideration of Legal Text

Andy Clasper (AC) explained work had commenced on the Legal Text, and that this would be completed when the final amended Modification had submitted.

#### 4. Review of Impacts and Costs

FC said that the costs would be covered within the Code obligations and delivered under the 'ad-hoc' UIG Task Force budget.

#### 5. Review of Relevant Objectives

FC said that it was her understanding that in terms of relevant objectives that would be furthered by implementation of the Modification; A, B and D were applicable.

#### 6. Consideration of Wider Industry Impacts

FC said she believed there was low impact to the Transporters and the end consumers, as Class 2 customers would have daily fitted equipment; most likely AMR.

#### 7. Development of Workgroup Report

AR explained that once the formally amended Modification was submitted then work could start on the Workgroup Report.

### 8. Review of Outstanding Actions

Action 0601: Centrica (IS) to follow-up with Kate Mulvany on the Class 2 issue and provide an update at the next meeting as to why Class 2 should not be included. Update: FC and Karen Kennedy (KK) both confirmed that this action could now be closed as Class 2 had now been included into the Modification. **Closed**
