SGN fully supports this Modification which proposes that the qualifying period for the requirement for a meter point to become Class 1 is reduced. SGN also supports the creation of additional reporting to help facilitate this change.

SGN believes this Modification will help increase the number of meter reads being supplied to the Central Data Services Provider (CDSP), which in turn will support the allocation of gas to the correct Supply Point. The Unidentified Gas (UIG) Task Force (as established under UNC Modification 0658) has identified that low rates of meter read performance can be a significant contributing factor to UIG. We feel this modification will help address this issue, which in turn will help in the securing of effective competition between relevant shippers.
